

Swipe Notebook

This consists entirely of magazine photos and website printouts. These are NOT your sketches or drawings. It is a REFERENCE collection to aid you when you draw.

In your notebook...

- Pictures must be neatly trimmed – no torn edges
 - They must be in plastic page protectors, one page per protector or front and back (be consistent)
 - Place paper between pics that are smaller than full page
 - Must have tabbed dividers in front of each category, label divider pages
 - Table of Contents for categories
 - Title Page on interior of notebook
 - Cover for Notebook (on outside) with name and title (separate from title page)
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- Be consistent: Either put your pictures in both the front AND back side of the page protectors throughout the notebook or fronts only, but don't switch back and forth. Otherwise, I'm likely to not count correctly.

Required Categories

- Poses
- Textures/Fabrics (either name)
- Accessories
- Faces (includes hair, make-up, expressions)
- Clothing
- Plus one category which you specify (make-up yourself)
 - You must have at least 1 category you make up yourself and have at least 5 pages in this category
 - Make sure you pick something that isn't already included in the other category. For instance, Hair is part of Faces, Bridal is part of Clothing. You're welcome to put subcategories in these sections, but that still doesn't count as coming up with something new.
 - Possibilities include
 - Details (embroidery, sewing details, etc.)
 - Miscellaneous (Fashion inspiration, photography, art...)
 - Backgrounds (Hint: backgrounds don't have models already in the photos. They are photos or textures or art or anything you could put a model in front of without any trouble.)
 - Historical Costume
 - Ethnic Influence

Requirements for Pre-Specified Categories (Don't forget to also make-up an additional category)

Pose Category:

Must have at least 14 poses – head to toe. I only count 1 pose per page. Body must be distinguishable beneath clothes.

Faces:

10 Faces minimum. All different moods, styles, expressions. Keep it modern. I only count 1 face per page.

Clothing:

Must have at least 20 garments. Choose things that are inspirational to you. But don't stick to one category. That is, not all bridal and evening wear. Have variety. I only count 1 per page.

Accessories:

Minimum 10 pages of accessories. I only count 1 per page. Ideas include:
Shoes

Boots
Hats
Belts
Purses
Sunglasses
Jewelry
Scarves
Hosiery
Socks
Gloves
Bags

Textures:

Must have at least 1 example each of 20 of the below textures/fabrics. Can have more than 1 example (but it doesn't count against the 20) and can have fabrics that aren't listed. The more you have, the easier it is to draw them. I only count 1 texture per page. *NOTE: These, like everything else in the project, are magazine/web PHOTOS. They are NOT actual fabric swatches. Find photos of clothes made of these fabrics. For instance, for satin, you could use a lady in satin ball gown or a satin puffer jacket. Just as long as it's made out of the specified fabric in a large enough amount, it's fine to use.* While it is not required, it is highly recommended that you label your textures so that it speeds up your ability to reference them. Over 40 textures are listed:
